The Austin console installed in 1979 has provisions for additional divisions in the west end of the church, as well as additions to the main organ. Changes to the Great Diapason Chorus carried out in the 70's have been reversed with the addition of pipework of nearly identical design and voicing to that originally installed in 1934.
